# **Chapter 2: Shared Goals**

### PROCESS

Recognizing the significant overlap in Comprehensive Plan policy statements from Blaine County<sup>254</sup> and its cities-Carey,<sup>255</sup> Bellevue,<sup>256</sup> Hailey,<sup>257</sup> Ketchum<sup>258</sup> and Sun Valley<sup>259</sup> - the Wood River Land Trust scoped the Community Planning program and its action plan objectives (Chapter 3) to stem from goals shared between three or more municipalities.
